4. All Levels are 20 minutes with fifteen (15) minute breaks at the completion of levels 6, 9, 12, and 19. Breaks may be added or adjusted based on Tournament Director’s discretion.
5. Ante will be posted by the Big Blind ONLY. Ante posted prior to the Big Blind.
6. Play will be 9-handed. Final Table will be 9-handed.
7. **Registration permitted through level 6 break.**
8. **No re-entry permitted.**
9. \$520 from each entrant goes to prize pool, \$55 is withheld for house revenue; \$25 is withheld for staff
10. Must be an MGM Rewards member to participate.
11. Must be 21 years or older to participate.
12. MGM National Harbor Poker Room reserves the right to alter, change, or cancel any tournament.
13. Seating may be limited
14. The event will generally follow the Tournament Director Association (TDA) rules. This event is subject to National Harbor poker room’s house rules, and any other applicable rules, with all decisions at the discretion of the poker room employee acting as the Tournament Director.
15. Winners will be paid in casino chips.
