1. Registration will begin at 9:00 a.m.
2. Players start with 35,000 in tournament chips.
3. Levels change every 30 minutes.
4. Antes posted by the Big Blind ONLY. Ante posted prior to the Big Blind.
5. Ten (10) minute breaks at the completion of levels 3, 6, 9, 12 (15 min), and 15. Further breaks will be the discretion of the tournament director.
6. Additional blind levels may be added if necessary.
7. **Late and re-entries are allowed for the first 6 levels.**
8. **Unlimited re-entries will be permitted.**
9. Play will be 9-handed. Final Table will be 9-handed.
10. \$294 from each entrant goes to prize pool, \$35 withheld for house revenue, and \$25 is withheld for staff. \$6 per player will be withheld to fund any guarantees and the tournament leaderboard.
11. The prize pool for this event is guaranteed at \$20,000. In the event the prize pool falls short of the guarantee, the balance will be paid from the MGM National Harbor Tournament Fund.
12. Must be an MGM Rewards member to participate.
13. Must be 21 years or older to participate.
14. MGM National Harbor Poker Room reserves the right to alter, change, or cancel any tournament.
15. Seating may be limited
16. Tournament Director's decision is final.
17. Winners will be paid in casino chips.
18. Winners must show a valid ID to collect winnings. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty are subject to withholding. Winners are responsible for any United States federal, state or local taxes and/or government fees that may be imposed in connection with the acceptance of the prize.
